

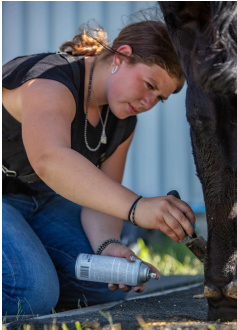
SHOW TEAM JUDGING - Team up to run your own show!

While one team member is sorting and judging the class, the other is working as the ring person to keep the show moving and the ring organized. Each member of the team is judged equally. Teams can be listed at time of entry or the show committee can help to arrange teammates.

HIND LEG COMPETITION - Work with a full slate of tools and a limited amount of time to fit the greatest hind leg of all time!

PHOTOGRAPHY - Step behind the lens to capture the greatest image possible.

- A) Pee Wee and Junior - Tools of the Trade - Agriculture has some of the most helpful and unique tools. Photograph a tool, piece of equipment or object that makes farm life easier. Write a short explanation to go along with your 4x6 picture and bring those to display at the show.
- B) Intermediate and Senior - Changing Public Perception - Sometimes the ag industry comes under fire. Photograph a scenario that could help to change the way an outsider might view your work. Write a paragraph of explanation to go along with your 4x6 picture and bring those to display at the show.



FENCING FACE-OFF - Hammer your way to cattle containment greatness! You will compete in a series of fencing challenges and race to stay in the game!

ROADSIDE BURGER SHACK - What can you and your team whip up? Each team will have ½ pound of ground beef and the chance to “shop” for ingredients. You’ll have one hour to build your burger empire including slogans, signage, photography and the burger itself before you open for business. Teams will be sent via email once entries have closed.

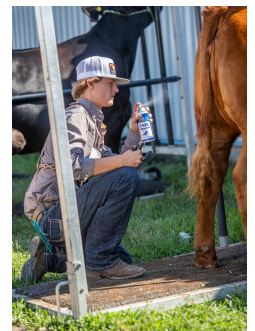


DRAGON’S DEN: GELBIEH EDITION - Make your pitch to the Dragons.

- B) Junior - Given a budget and a menu of options, you’ll make a series of decisions on your way to the show. Are you hiring fitters or trading help with your friends? You’ll need to stay on budget then share your plan with judges.
- C) Intermediate and Senior - Your job is to create a business plan and pitch your idea to judges in hopes of securing the funding you need to make your business a reality. Not only will you need to sell your business idea but also provide Dragons with all the facts!



BARN TRIBES - Just like Survivor, work as a team to win immunity (or maybe just a great prize). Teams will be judged by a secret panel with a focus on unity, work ethic and team spirit.
